

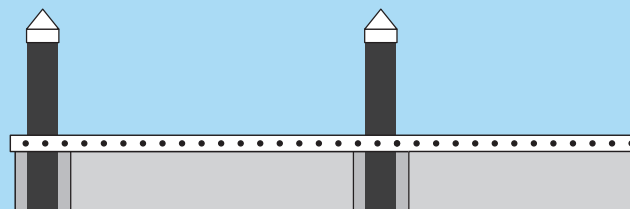
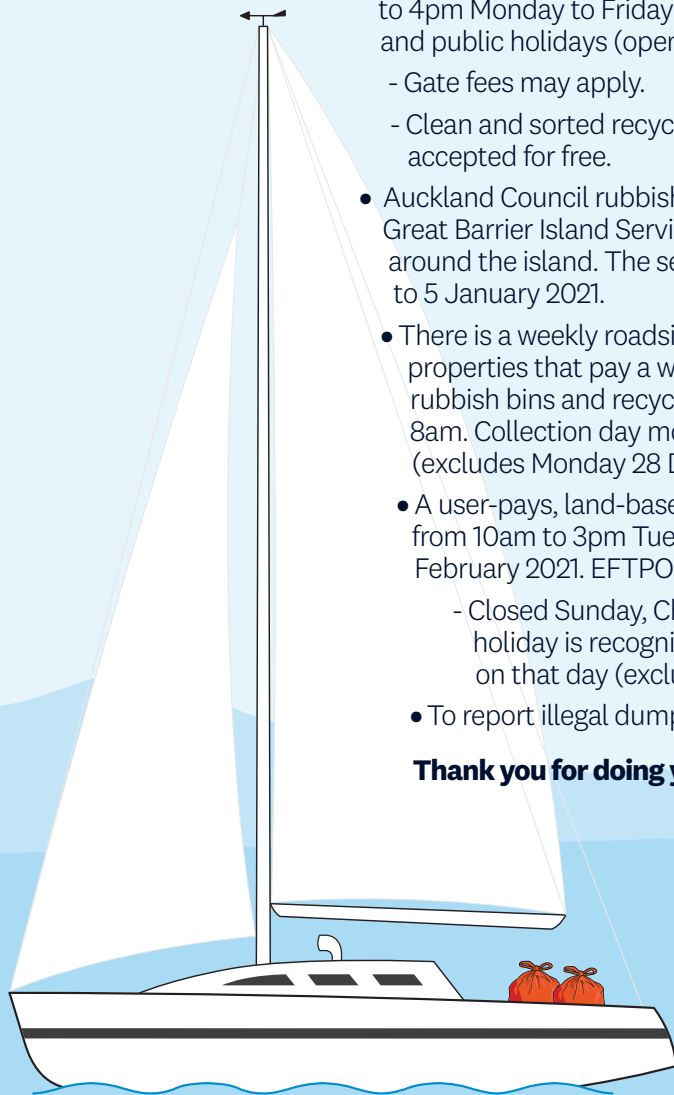
Plan to leave nothing behind

When you visit Aotea / Great Barrier Island, please minimise your waste.

There are limited waste services on the island. If you must dispose of any waste, here's what you need to know:

- There are no public rubbish bins on the island.
- You can drop off your waste and recycling to Claris Landfill at 70 Gray Road.
 - Extended hours between 21 December 2020 and 6 February 2021 are 9am to 4pm Monday to Friday and 10am to 3pm every Saturday. Closed Sunday and public holidays (open Saturday 6 February 2021).
 - Gate fees may apply.
 - Clean and sorted recycling and Auckland Council rubbish bags are accepted for free.
- Auckland Council rubbish bags are available for purchase from the Aotea / Great Barrier Island Service Centre and may be available from local stores around the island. The service centre is closed from 23 December 2020 to 5 January 2021.
- There is a weekly roadside rubbish and recycling collection service for properties that pay a waste charge. Place your council rubbish bags, rubbish bins and recycling crates out on the roadside on Monday, before 8am. Collection day moves to Tuesday if Monday is a public holiday (excludes Monday 28 December 2020).
- A user-pays, land-based drop-off service will be open at Port Fitzroy wharf from 10am to 3pm Tuesday to Saturday between 19 December 2020 and 8 February 2021. EFTPOS only.
 - Closed Sunday, Christmas Day and New Year's Day. Where a public holiday is recognised on a Monday, the drop-off service will operate on that day (excludes Monday 28 December 2020).
- To report illegal dumping, call 0800 NO DUMP (0800 663 867).
